If your interested in joining the LOE or have any questions, please feel free to contact myself, or any one of our officers. We would love to have you!

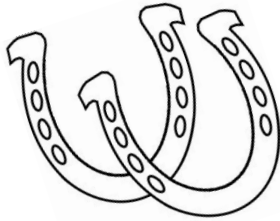
