Because our liquor license requires the liability insurance and without Grand Lodge assistance, we could not afford to purchase that insurance locally and without the insurance we can not keep the bar open. Remember that this is an Elks Lodge that happens

to have a bar, not a bar that happens to be an Elks Lodge.

One final note about the bar. There have been complaints about the language in the bar and the Board of Directors have been looking at possible solutions from a "swear jar" to possible bar privilege suspensions if we can't police ourselves and curb the bad language. Please be more aware of the words that we use and how offensive they can be to some patrons.

The Utah Elks Association Spring Meeting will be in St. George on March 9-11th. Our Grand Exalted Ruler will be the very special guest at that meeting. There are registration forms in the office and a deadline for host hotel reservations on February 22nd. Anyone can attend and this is a great opportunity to meet our Grand Exalted Ruler.




If you are interested in any of these positions, please contact me or any of the current officers. We will be happy to explain what is involved in these positions.
