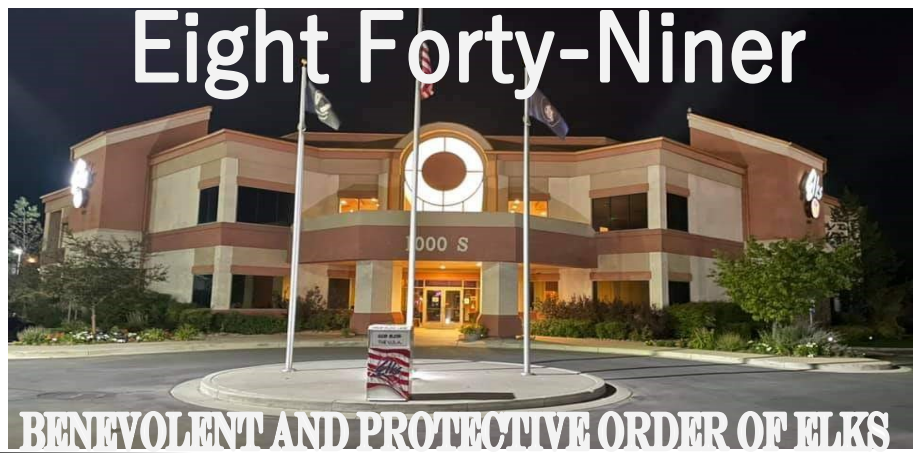

OFFICERS - Sept. Board mtg is Wed. Sept 6th at 6 in the LOE room.

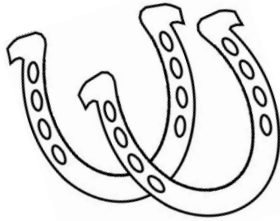

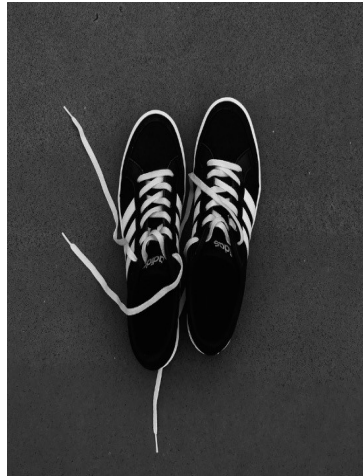
