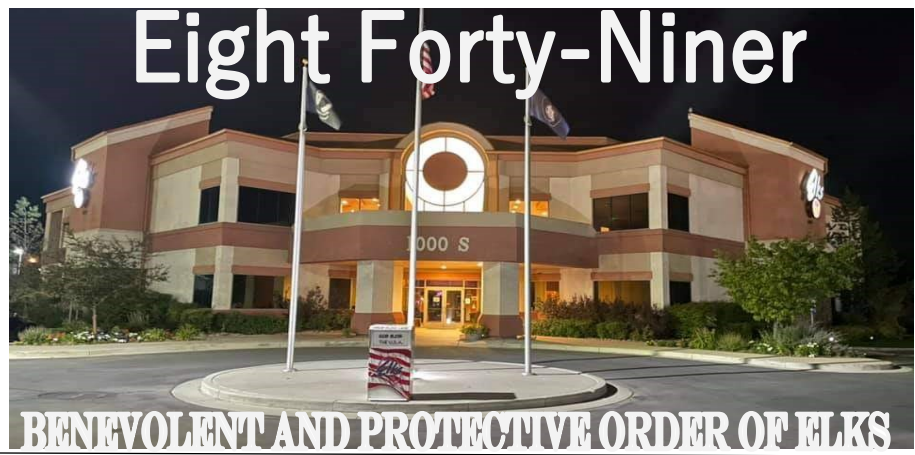

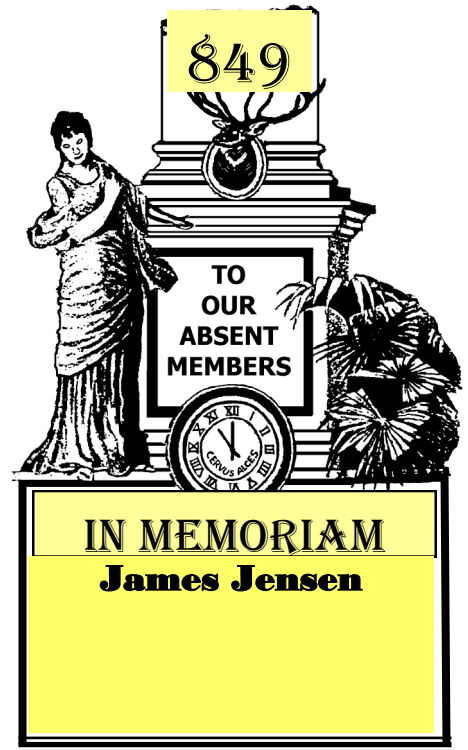

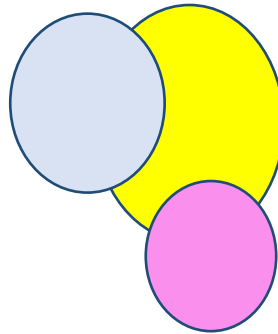

Enjoy your summer be safe and stay cool. The Elks have some great activities happening- lets make sure to support them.

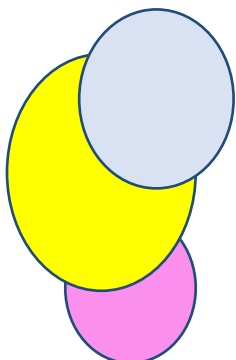
